- In 2012, Dr. Benton was the director of the counseling service at a very large, public university
- Waiting list issues for students wishing to see counselors at the counseling center.
- University could not afford to hire enough counselors to meet demand





- A pervasive problem
- HHS Report* Findings:
 - 56% of counties have no licensed behavior health providers
 - 91 million U.S. citizens being underserved

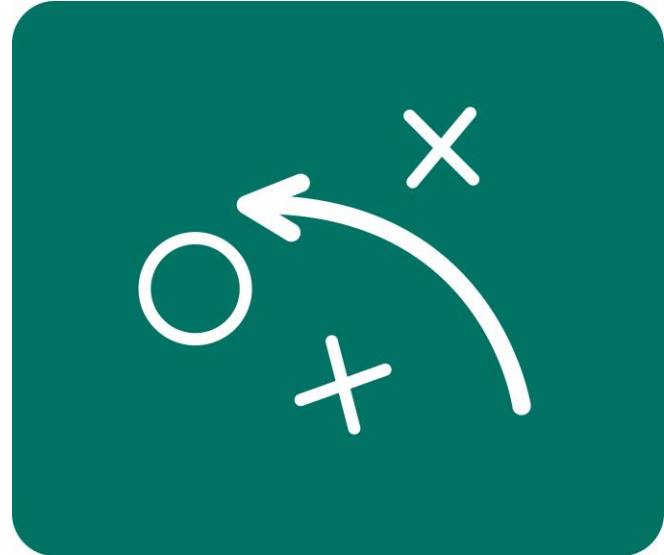

The Goal

- Change patient's behavior
- Change neural pathways
- Repetition is important - learner engagement is paramount
- Accessibility





The Solution:

- Create eLearning tools for patient treatment
- Cut down on therapists' time burden; increase patient engagement
- “Flipped Classroom” concept – more time spent on self-learning
- Patients practice skills and gain insights on their own
- eLearning meant to be a reflective exercise



The Benefits:

- Uses resources more effectively
 - Cuts traditional 50 minute face-to-face therapy time down to 10-15 minutes
- Allows for broader reach of behavioral health services
- Increased patient engagement leading to better outcomes

How do you make the eLearning tools/course engaging and effective?

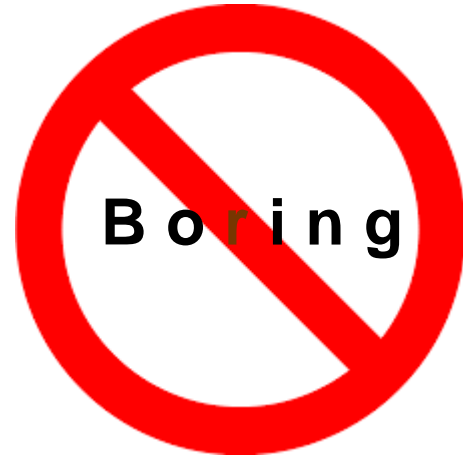
- Tao Connect lacked in-house skills to make the eLearning courses exciting and keep the attention of the patients(learners).

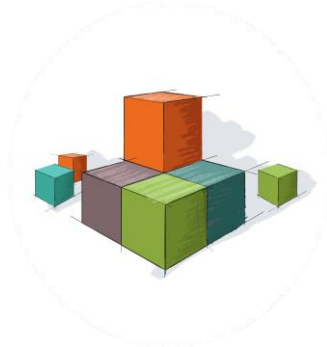
