









Curb Cut Effect





Smartphone Ownership in the US by Age




- On average, most children receive their first smartphone at age 11.







On Dumpster Diving

LARS EIGHNER

Las Eighner was born in 1948 in Corpus Christi, Texas. "On Dumpster Diving" is excerpted from Travels with Lizbeth, a chronicle of Eighner's three years as a homeless person. Lizbeth is the author's dog and traveling companion. Typed on equipment found in the garbage. Travels with Lizbeth began as a series of letters to friends describing the events that took Eighner from a job in a mental institution to life as a homeless person. The book is written as a series of vigenets because, as the author says. "A homeless life has no story line."

In a sober ione purclusted with sharp detail, Eighner describes, analyzes, and philosophizes about the things we as a society discard. Often these an things Eighner finite spericely usable. Although the author doesn't directly draw conclusions for the reader, his careful descriptions of what we consider grandger make a statement about our "disposable" society and about what we value, whether we are homeless or not.


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
