Getting Started with AI in L&D

Assess Training Needs

Identify areas where AI can provide the most value (e.g., automating content creation, frameworks, etc.)

Review Technology Infrastructure

Evaluate existing systems and determine if upgrades/new tools are needed to support Al functionality

Share Best Practices

Provide continuous training and share best practices with team to improve efforts

Get Stakeholder Buy-In

Engage with leadership, IT, and HR to ensure alignment and understanding of Al's potential benefits and limitations

START SMALL!

Test AI solutions with a pilot group, allowing for controlled experimentation and adjustments before a full-scale rollout



Overcome Common Challenges

Bias in Al Algorithms

Ensure AI tools are evaluated for potential biases – implement regular audits to check for unintended discrimination

Transparency and Accountability

Communicate how AI is being used in training programs and ensure stakeholders understand role and limitations

Performance Metrics

Implement clear KPI's to track AI's impact – monitor time saved in content development or improvements in learner engagement

Data Privacy and Security

Safeguard employee data by ensuring AI systems comply with data protection regulations (e.g., GDPR, CCPA)

Change Management

Address resistance to AI adoption by providing training/resources to promote understanding of how AI can support rather than replace roles

Prompt Engineering: Best Practices

Be Specific and Clear

Craft detailed, precise prompts to get accurate and relevant responses. Avoid ambiguity to prevent confusion.

Provide Context

Include background information or specify the role the AI should take (e.g., "explain as if you're an expert trainer").

Iterate and Refine

Start with a simple prompt, review the output, and refine the prompt to improve responses based on initial result.

Set Boundaries

Clearly outline what should and should not be included in the response (e.g., "avoid discussing technical jargon").

Use Step-by-Step Instructions

For complex tasks, break down the request into smaller steps to ensure clarity and accuracy.

Limit Response Length

Specify if you want concise or detailed responses to control depth of output (e.g., "summarize in 3 sentences").





Prompt Engineering: Example

Example Prompt:

I am creating a video on the concept of facilitation strategies. Please provide me a video narration script that conforms to the following parameters:

- 1. This script is for the opening video and needs to contain an elevator pitch to grab attention, introduce the topic, and build its relevance
- 2. The script should define the concept of facilitation within the context of corporate training
- 3. The script should be written for an Englishspeaking international audience
- 4. The script should be written and targeted at a CEFR B2 readability level and should be 300 words or less

Narration Script:
