Review Criteria

- Is the session designed to do what it proposes to do?
- Is the session topic relevant and engaging?
- Does the proposed session offer relevant, practical, applicable professional development opportunities for attendees?
- Does the proposal reflect quality, expertise, and excellence?
- If required, was a speaking video provided?

- Proposal Overview and Background
 - Session type, audience, speakers, topic
 - Background and speaker expertise
- Proposed Session Design
 - Session description, agenda, learning outcomes, key challenges
- Proposal Materials
 - 4-6 slides related to proposed topic (required) - All proposals
 - Speaker Video required for New to ATD speakers
- Speaker and Conference Policies and Submission


